Preparing for Pre-Application (science grant proposers)

Pre-Application Deadline: April 16, 2012

For science grant proposers, an on-line **Pre-Application Form will be available, via www.newfrontiersinastronomy.org, after March 15, 2012.**

The information requested (described below) is for the purpose of selecting the best reviewers for the proposals.

Please read the RFP for science grants, and prepare answers to the following questions. Then return to this site after March 15, 2012 to access the Pre-Application Form.

This is NOT needed for ESSAY writers.

1. Which Big Question and which exemplary question are you proposing to address? (see RFP from this website).
2. Provide the name, title, institution, contact information, field of study or occupation of the Principal Investigator (who will also be the single point of contact for your proposal).
3. What is the title of your proposal?
4. Is your proposal for work that is theoretical, experimental, computational, laboratory or "other" (specify)?
5. What focused question will you be trying to answer? (That is, what will you actually be spending money on?)
6. Give the names and contact information of three individuals who would be good referees for your proposal?
7. What is the total estimated cost of your proposed effort (U.S. Dollars)?
8. What are the names, titles, institutions, addresses, and positions or occupations of all co-Investigators (maximum of five)?

We will also be interested in how you first hear about this opportunity.
